**College Rider and College Rider Xtra
CONDITIONS OF ISSUE
(Stagecoach and Franklin College)**

- 1 College Rider/College Rider Xtra passes are issued for the full term to students who are attending Franklin College full time. Passes are available for use on term days and weekend, but not during holiday periods.
- 2
 - a College Rider/College Rider Xtra passes are subject to, and must be used only in conformity with Stagecoach rules, regulations and arrangements from time to time in force.
 - b Stagecoach will not accept any liability for consequences arising from the discontinuance, whether permanent or otherwise, of the running of any buses. In the event of the permanent withdrawal of a service Stagecoach will refund the value of the unexpired portion of pass issued on that service.
 - c Stagecoach will not accept liability for consequences arising from alterations in the starting or arrival times of any bus service, for want of accommodation in any bus, for delay in arrival at the destinations or for non-arrival, nor for any delay in the arrival of relief buses or for non supply of relief buses.
- 3 A photograph is not needed for the College Rider/College Rider Xtra (we will use the photograph held on FIS). The passes are not transferable. In the event of a breach of this condition, both the person using it and the person who transferred it will be liable to prosecution.
- 4 College Rider/College Rider Xtra passes must be shown to the driver on each journey and must be produced on demand to any officer or other servant of Stagecoach. If a pass is not so shown and produced, the holder thereof shall be deemed not to possess a ticket and must pay the ordinary fare for the journey in question. No refund of such a fare will be made.
- 5 The holder of a College Rider/College Rider Xtra is not entitled to priority of place over the other passengers. No seat may be reserved.
- 6 Stagecoach and Franklin College reserves the right to decline to issue or renew a College Rider/College Rider Xtra pass.
- 7 Should a College Rider/College Rider Xtra pass be lost immediate notice must be given to Stagecoach and Franklin College. A duplicate pass may, at the discretion of the College, be issued upon payment of the sum of £10. Should the original pass be subsequently found, it must be returned at once to the College.
- 8 If a pass be defaced or become illegal, the holder shall return it to the College who will issue a new one in exchange for the charge of £10.00.
- 9 The holder of a College Rider/College Rider Xtra is not entitled to an allowance in respect of the non-use of the pass. The College may, at its discretion, give a refund where certified medical absence of a prolonged period occurs.
- 10 A College Rider/College Rider Xtra pass is liable to forfeiture if there is a breach of any of these conditions.
- 11 The acceptance of a College Rider/College Rider Xtra will be held to constitute an acceptance of conditions set.
- 12 If a student leaves the College before half term they can obtain a refund for the following half term on production of the pass to the Finance Office. Students who leave College after half term will not be eligible for a refund.

**Coopers Pass
CONDITIONS OF ISSUE
(Coopers and Franklin College)**

- 1 The Coopers Pass can be used on college days only.
- 2 A photograph is not needed for the Coopers Pass (we will use the photograph held on FIS). The passes are not transferable. In the event of a breach of this Condition, both the person using it and the person who transferred it will be liable to prosecution.
- 3 Coopers passes must be shown to the driver on each journey. If a pass is not so shown and produced, the holder thereof shall be deemed not to possess a ticket and must pay the ordinary fare for the journey in question. No refund of such a fare will be made.
- 4 Should a Coopers pass be lost immediate notice must be given to Franklin College. A duplicate pass may, at the discretion of the College, be issued upon payment of the sum of £10. Should the original pass be subsequently found, it must be returned at once to the College.
- 5 If a pass be defaced or become illegal, the holder shall return it to the College who will issue a new one in exchange for the charge of £10.00.
- 6 The holder of a Coopers pass is not entitled to an allowance in respect of the non-use of the pass.
