
NHS Blood and Transplant Work Experience



The Impact and Influence of Kate Greenaway on Illustrated Books

ABSTRACT

Far more than book reviews, it is literary prizes that shape the afterlives of new titles. Regardless of who is nominated or who wins, literary awards recognise the fact that books are a culturally important part of our lives.

In 1955, the [British] Library Association named the Kate Greenaway Medal after the beloved artist Kate Greenaway (1846-1901) who produced fine art illustrations and books for children that have been praised by many art critics for her depictions of children in countryside settings. For nearly seven decades, the award signified quality illustrated books for those which were long listed for the Greenaway prize. In 2022, CILIP (formerly the Library Association) quietly removed her name. Hundreds of artists and illustrators protested this decision, and hundreds of authors, historians, librarians, parents, and teachers denounced the decision to replace her name on the prestigious award with a controversial industrialist.

How did Kate Greenway's art reach and move generations of children? How do named literary prizes influence book sales and the publishing trade? How do library associations run book awards? This talk by historian and librarian, Dr Rose Roberto, will answer these questions.
