



Al, Smartphones and Lung Health: Breathless with Excitement Webinar with UCL Faculty of Medical Sciences

This talk will demonstrate how data from the sensors on your smartphone, such as the camera and microphone, can be combined with AI to recognise breathing in real-time and measure lung function. You'll hear about how this data can be used to make breathing exercises much more enjoyable and interactive, and look at a smartphone platform that is under development for patients with asthma and COPD. You'll also briefly touch upon some of the limitations, and potential pitfalls, of using AI in health care.

The lecture will introduce artists and intellectuals such as Eddy Sackville-West, Stephen Tomlin and Julia Strachey, who led an unapologetic life by pushing gender boundaries and social conventions, as well as exploring gender fluidity and pansexuality.

A SPOTLIGHT

Allied Health Professionals

What is an Allied Health Professional?

AHPs are the third largest workforce in the NHS and provide system-wide care to assess, treat, diagnose and discharge patients across all organisations. AHPs are involved in managing patients' care of all ages by using a holistic approach, to start well, live well and age well. As an allied health professional you'll be able to help patients in ways that few other healthcare professionals can, whether that's by helping someone learn to walk again or fixing a child's squint. You'll work alongside a multidisciplinary team of doctors and nurses, in a range of settings including hospitals and patient's homes, as you help patients overcome obstacles, both mentally and physically.

The fourteen allied health professions are art therapists, dieticians, dramatherapists, music therapists, occupational therapists, operating department practitioners, orthoptists, osteopaths, paramedics, physiotherapists, prosthetists and orthotists, radiographers and speech and language therapists. You can find more about each of these roles here.

How do I become one?

The main route into becoming an allied health professional is by completing a degree. Healthcare degrees are a hands-on, dynamic way of learning that will give you experience like no other. During your studies, you'll complete placements, meet other specialists and get a taste for what the role is really like. Depending on which course you choose, your studies will last two to four years.

There are full and part-time courses available across the country and you can use this course finder to browse them. For some AHP roles, you can train through a degree apprenticeship. This involves a combination of academic study and practical, paid employment, and typically lasts around four years. Click here to find out more about how to become an allied health professional.

What can I do in the meantime?

While you may think there's little you can do to boost your career whilst you're studying at college, there are plenty of things you can get involved with!
