

Dear Parents/Carers,

To promote independent digital learning and provide revision support classes, we will operate a revised summer timetable from **Monday 10<sup>th</sup> June** until the end of term on Friday 5<sup>th</sup> July.

Students will **only** attend the longer 3-hour lessons, with the shorter 1.5-hour lessons moving to independent study, revision, and digital learning for Aspire. There will be virtual and in person one to ones for Aspire for personal statement preparation.

Students should consult with their tutors and Progress Coach for guidance on expectations and assigned work during this period.

When not in a timetabled on-site lesson, students can opt to stay in college for study, but Franklin buses will depart at 1pm, to allow students to have lunch except on Tuesdays when the bus will depart at 4.15pm. Those who plan to stay on-site should arrange their own transport.

Year 2 students are required to attend until their last exam or submission of final coursework. Any Year 2 student who has an afternoon exam from 1pm will be contacted by the Exams Team to assess transport needs. There will be a Leavers event for Year 2 students on Friday 24<sup>th</sup> May in The Quad for celebrations and an opportunity to collect leavers' hoodies.

All Level 2 students are expected to participate in the transition programme post GCSE Maths and English exams, starting from Monday 10<sup>th</sup> June to Friday 19<sup>th</sup> June.

For students receiving financial support, the daily meal allowance will remain accessible at The Buzz, Frankie's, and the College shop throughout this period, until Friday 5<sup>th</sup> July.

Attendance during this adjusted timetable is crucial for progression onto the next academic year. Non-attendance may jeopardise student's college place and future progression opportunities.

Please note that the normal timetable will operate in the week commencing Monday 3<sup>rd</sup> June and this change comes into effect on Monday 10<sup>th</sup> June. The timetable from September 2024 will return to normal onsite delivery.
