Matias has continued with this project whilst he studies and works in the UK, he is now trying to promote the project so that he can make another donation for Christmas.


"Some of these children have never had a Christmas, I want to give them that family time".



What is Entrepreneurship?

Entrepreneurship is all about dreaming big and making it happen! Entrepreneurs spot gaps in the market and create businesses from scratch. Whether it's your local coffee shop or a cool new app, entrepreneurs are everywhere, bringing fresh ideas to life.

What areas of entrepreneurship are out there?

- **Business Entrepreneur:** Think of the classic entrepreneur who starts businesses to make money. They turn ideas into profit-driven companies that meet people's needs.
- Project Entrepreneur. These folks are all about organising cool events or short-term initiatives, like festivals or campaigns. They bring creative projects to life without locking into a permanent business.
- **Social entrepreneur:** If you want to make a difference, social entrepreneurs are your people. They build organisations aimed at solving social issues while mixing mission and profit.
