



What is a career in Science and Research like?

Building, creating and investigating: these are just a few of the exciting functions of a scientist. Scientists, technologists, engineers and mathematicians all use technical expertise and methodologies to test theories, invent new things and generally discover more about the world around us. Scientists develop new chemicals, foods, drugs and materials, investigate disease and the environmental impacts of pollution, develop software, help our buildings stay standing, explore the universe and even predict the weather.

Is a career in Science and Research for me?

People with STEM skills are in serious demand — in fact, there is currently a shortage of STEM skills. STEM skills include things like data analysis and interpreting statistics. But you might be surprised to learn that there are other very important skills to develop if you'd like a career in science and research. These include problem solving, creativity, debating and communication. So, when considering whether science is the career for you, try to answer these questions... Are you curious? Do you enjoy thinking about how things work? Do you take a creative approach to solving problems?

Scientists and mathematicians can spend a lot of time gathering evidence or testing out theories before they get a result, so you'd also have to be patient and precise, with good attention to detail. Scientists tend to be organised, analytical and logical. They need strong communication skills to explain their research and findings to others.
