GB Renewables Map


Are you interested in renewables and offshore wind?



A SPOTLIGHT

Agriculture and Environment

From the food we eat to the air we breathe, careers in agriculture & environment support things that are crucial to our everyday lives.

What is agriculture and environment?

The agriculture and environment sector has never been more important than it is today. People who work in this industry deal with how we use, maintain, and protect our natural resources, including the food we eat – issues that are hot topics in the modern world. Growing concerns about the environment and plans to boost British farming have spurred politicians and the public into action, leading to a bigger focus on being environmentally friendly and buying locally produced food.

This means more and more jobs are becoming available in the agriculture and environment sector. And as the industry has become more sophisticated, so too have the roles.

What agriculture and environment jobs can I do?

There are plenty of jobs available in agriculture and environment, some of them including agricultural engineers, botanists, ecologists, environmental consultants, environmental managers, environmental scientists, farmers, farm managers, farm workers, florists, forest/woodland managers, gardeners, horticultural managers, landscape architects, meteorologists, park and countryside rangers, recycling officers, recycling operatives, tree surgeons and so many more!

Is a career in agriculture and environment for me?

If you care passionately about the environment, love working with plants or animals or just can't get enough of the great outdoors, then this is the industry for you. Many careers in agriculture and the environment involve at least some outdoor work and some people in this industry will spend most of their working day outside, whatever the weather. Hours can be long and may vary depending on the season, and for some jobs you will need to be physically fit too.

What qualifications are available?

There are lots of opportunities to develop your skills on the job. Agricultural colleges and professional bodies like the National Farmers Union and the Institute of Agricultural Management often run short courses, workshops and seminars focused on professional development. In certain jobs, such as an agriculture engineer or landscape architect, you could work towards chartered status.

The Connected Brain: Network and Communication with Gresham College

The brain is mostly organised into small modular regions connected to each other. Typically, each region performs different cognitive tasks, from image processing to language. This organisation leads us to model the brain as a network, the 'brain connectome'. This fundamental view of the brain has become a central paradigm for neurosciences linking topological properties of networks to brain functions. This lecture presents ideas from graph theory to study this network and understand the way that the brain learns and operates.
