





Fashion & Beauty

Fashion and beauty is all about creating, styling and looking your best. It's big business too, with endless jobs for trendsetters and innovators who want to make their mark.

What Fashion & Beauty jobs can I do?

- **Cosmetic chemist:** Science meets beauty. Cosmetic chemists create and improve makeup, skincare and perfumes. They're behind that perfect foundation or long-lasting lip colour.
- Dressmaker: Creates unique, made-to-order clothes like wedding dresses or festival fits.
- **Fashion designer:** Turns inspiration into styles you actually want to wear. Fashion designers work on everything from high-street looks to luxury pieces.
 - **Fashion photographer:** Makes fashion look fire through stunning images. They shoot everything from runway shows to editorial spreads, turning clothes into art.
- Fashion PR officer: Creates hype for brands and keeps them in the public eye. Fashion PR
 pros know how to get everyone talking.
- **Makeup artist:** Turns faces into masterpieces. Makeup artists work on shoots, runways or even theatre, creating everything from glam looks to movie makeup magic.
- Model: Models are the faces of fashion, from runway to Instagram shoots. They make the clothes come alive.
 - Spa therapist: Helps clients relax with massages and treatments in luxury spas. Spa therapists know how to create the perfect chill-out experience.

What are the top skills required to work in Fashion & Beauty?

Communication is essential for making clients happy and collaborating on big projects. It's all about getting your message across. Creativity helps you bring new styles and solutions to life. Fashion and beauty are all about standing out. Customer service keeps clients coming back. Whether in a salon or retail, great service makes all the difference. People skills - fashion and beauty is about connecting with clients and teammates. Good vibes matter. Teamwork - working with others is key, whether you're backstage at a show or in a salon. Collaboration makes everything better - and easier!

How do I start a career in fashion and beauty?

You can do apprenticeships such as Advanced Beauty Therapy or Hairdressing – hands-on experience can really pay off! Uni is also a great choice for jobs like fashion design, journalism, or cosmetic science. You can get certified through groups such as the Chartered Society of Designers, or the National Association of Screen Makeup Artists – these really help you level up in the industry.
